Dear Families,

I'm sure you will have seen in the news that there have been outbreaks of measles in Birmingham and more recently in London. It is likely that we will see cases in the southeast. The key protection from measles is the full MMR vaccine (both doses).

The government have setup a catch-up campaign. Although the campaign is aimed at 6-11-year-olds, any pupil that has not had the full two doses of the MMR vaccine can contact their GP to make an appointment.

Dear Parents / Carers

You may have noticed the recent BBC news coverage on the increase in measles outbreaks.

https://www.bbc.co.uk/news/topics/cgee2gz4vk1t. Measles is a highly infectious disease, especially within schools, and can be very serious.

NHS England has launched a national MMR catch-up campaign. Over the next few months, children aged 6 to 11 who are missing one or two doses of the MMR vaccine will be invited to contact their GP practice to check their immunisation history and book an appointment for the MMR vaccination. Your local Children's Immunisation Team will also be holding local community clinics for 6- to 11-year-olds.
